

Role Summary

Job Responsibilities

- Organize and assist in development, implementation and evaluation of Fall & Winter Recreation Programs and LIT program, L.E.A.D Youth Leadership Development Program, and recreational engagement programs;
- Adapt activities, as needed, to allow active participation by youth with social/physical disabilities or behavioural concerns, encouraging social interaction between all youth at camp;
- Engage with youth in a meaningful way that encourages their growth, confidence, independence, belonging and social skills;
- Ensure the safety and supervision of and youth volunteers;
- Assist with development of youth engagement resources such as surveys, and volunteer position creations;
- Facilitate adaptations of activities to meet changing health guidelines of COVID-19 pandemic;
- Work with an understanding and sensitivity to the multi-cultural needs of our community;
- Act as a mentor and coach to LIT's to help develop important transferable skills;
- Adhere to guidelines, policies, procedures of organization to ensure highest quality of service delivery;
- Attend and participate in weekly morning meetings;
- Complete operational duties such as opening/closing duties, set up and clean up;
- Complete any accident, incident, discipline or report forms as required;
- Maintain confidentiality of participant phone numbers, health issues, and site concerns while acting as point of contact to parents/guardians;
- Work with a high-quality standard; being a role model in all aspects;
- Perform other related duties, as assigned by the Recreation Coordinator or Program Coordinator, as required to meet organization objectives.
